## EXAMPLE OF NSDI TASKS To test existing NSDI structure

The general question for each task is "How do you go about this task, given the set-up of your coordination structure?"

The presented solution should include an answer to who will do what, when?

# 1

- A subject informs you that they will develop a new dataset and need to know in what INSPIRE theme the new dataset will fall under. How do you handle the request given the set-up of your coordination structure?



# 2

- The quality of metadata is lacking among the subjects, how to do to improve it given the set-up of your coordination structure?



# 3

- There is a proposal of change in the legal INSPIRE framework that will affect the national SDI implementation.
  1. There is a proposal on EU-level on changing the data structure as specified in a technical guidance. You need to assess the consequences this change will have on national level.
  2. The EU-commission has decided to add a metadata element to the INSPIRE metadata profile. You need to implement this in the national Geoportal (and the national profile).
  3. The EU-commission has amended the INSPIRE requirements on network services. You need to assess the consequences this change will have on national level.
- How do you go about these three examples, given the set-up of your coordination structure?

- You are about to develop a data sharing model which will involve several stakeholders. How do you go about it given the set-up of your coordination structure?



# 5

- The Management/Government need to see the development (on a regular basis) of the implementation of the infrastructure. How do you handle the request given the set-up of your coordination structure?

- A subject call and ask you to show/train the staff at in the subjects' organisation in production and publishing of metadata. How do you handle the request given the set-up of your coordination structure?

- A subject call and ask how they can take part in the national data sharing. How do you handle the request given the set-up of your coordination structure?

- ELS\* requires services from Western Balkan. How do you handle the request given the set-up of your coordination structure?
  - Can existing SDI (discovery service) be used? If not, who is the main contact for further discussions? Who needs to be involved to be able to give an answer to the request?

- A subject informs you that a particular standard, required by the INSPIRE-directive, can't be implemented due to certain reasons. How do you put this issue forward given the set-up of your coordination structure?

- You have discovered that the subjects aren't taken on the production and publishing of metadata seriously and you need to address the issue. How do you go about it given the set-up of your coordination structure?

- A subject call and ask you to explain to them how the NSDI will affect them as an organisation. How do you handle the request given the set-up of your coordination structure?

- A new version of the software on which your Geoportal is based on has been released and you need to address the issue of upgrading. How do you go about it given the set-up of your coordination structure?

- How to effectively organize a NSDI Council meeting?

- A subject call and tell you they have problems understanding the requirements on network services and want you to help them off. How do you handle the request given the set-up of your coordination structure?

- Inspire MIG-T is a forum where fruitful news about SDI is discussed. How to get this information and how to spread this to other experts and other subjects, given the set-up of your coordination structure?

- The Management/Government require a cost/benefit analyse from you as the SDI coordinator. How to carry out a Cost/benefit calculation?
  - A template has been presented within the IMPULS project, in what way could that template be used an developed to fit your purpose?
